The 11th edition of VIV China 2018 closed its doors after three days of business and intensive networking on 19th September 2018, in Nanjing. With an exhibition space of 40,000 square meters gross, and one-fourth of the exhibitors coming from abroad, the event welcomed

16,156 visits this year. Domestic visitors came for 25.4% from Jiangsu province and 64.6% from Eastern China. 2,047 overseas professionals attended VIV China 2018 with South East Asia in the lead. Professional delegations from Indonesia, Korea, Vietnam, Thailand, Philippines, India, and other countries attended the show with trading purposes. The new location in Nanjing created a good opportunity to expand VIV China customer group.


